Vol. 54 (2018 – Ingonish, NS) - 9 papers, 127pp.

Vol. 55 (2019 – Spokane, Wa) – 9 papers, 135 pp.

Vol. 56 (2020 – Carrabassett Valley, ME)

8 papers – 140+ pp. (4 posted, 4 in copyediting)

Vol. 57 (2021 – virtual, Minnesota)

3 papers in review.

2. CSP Publishing Services (current publisher) (by Art Rodgers, Business Editor)

CSP was formerly the National Res. Council of Can. Press, and is now independent and not-for-profit. Charges include \$37 Cdn/printed page and \$125/hr labour. We have a 2-yr contract which expires 31 Dec., 2023.

3. Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ)

Alces is currently listed in DOAJs but we have yet to provide metadata to make the listing more accessible (ie. ToCs, Abstracts Links to PDFs). Jason Ferrante (USGS, FL) has loaded the metadata for Vol. 53 and half of Vol. 54 (2018) as a trial exercise.

5. Printed Copies of Alces

Paper copies are no longer available except for a very limited number which are printed for a few abstracting services. Decision to go electronic was made at 51st (2017) NAMCW.

Summary

- -Journal production costs per issue are \$5-6,000.
- Alces provides \$1,500 per year for the Albert W. Franzmann and Distinguished Colleagues Award and up to \$7,000 per year for the Newcomers, Senior's, and DMB Travel Award (travel awards not given in 2020 and 2021). Much of these award expenses are sometimes recouped from conference proceeds.

- the Alces Account is held at Lakehead University, Thunder Bay, ON and had a balance on October 31, 2021 of \$74,740.91. This is right on the reserve target of \$75K decided at the 51st NAMCW. Our annual account growth since 2011 has been -\$4,262.52. Having stopped printing the journal has now reduced our costs by about \$4,500 per issue (printing and mailing).
