- 1. **Approval of the Agenda** M: Cedric Alexander; S: Gerry Redmond CARRIED.
- 2. **Alces Update** Chief Editor, Pete Pekins.
- <u>Vol. 52</u> (Middle Park, CO) is complete. It is available on the Alces website and paper copies have been mailed.
 - <u>Vol. 53</u> (Brandon, MB) presently includes 19 papers (220 pp.), which are posted on the website. Plan to "close" this volume, post on line, print and mail by Dec. 2017.
 - <u>Vol. 54</u> (2018) will be posted on line as papers are accepted. Complete citations with page numbers will be provided at the time of posting.
- 3. Alces Budget 2015-2017 Art Rodgers, Business Editor.
 - copy editing of papers for Alces is being handled by CSP Publishing Services (formerly NRC Research Press), Ottawa, ON. Charge is \$28/printed page; 1-year contract will be renewed Dec. 31, 2017.
 - details of "cash flow by project" were presented and summarized. Major annual cost per meeting include:
 - Production costs and postage per issue \$6,000 to \$7,000.
 - Costs per annual meeting (mostly travel awards) about \$9,000.
 - Franzmann and Dist. Colleagues Memorial Research Award \$1500. In most years, these costs are recouped through conference proceeds. The growth of the Alces Account averaged + \$1,389.64 per year from 2000 to 2010 but since then has averaged (- \$4,499.11) per year.

- In 2010, a decision was made to spend the fund down somewhat by making more travel awards available. Accordingly, it has been spent down from a previous high of \$105,630 to the current balance of \$55,632.
- after the books are closed on the Brandon and Cape Breton Meetings, a balance of about \$75K is expected. At current spending rates, the account will continue to decline over time.
- several options were discussed to guide future spending. This led to 3 motions:
- **1. Moved:** to eliminate paper copies of the journal over the next 5 years.

- the intention was that the journal become fully available on line while we might continue to print a small number of copies for archival purposes.
- **2. Moved:** that spending be managed so as to keep the size of the Alces Account in future years around \$75K.

3. Moved: that Newcomer Travel Awards be available up to at least a value of \$4K per year and all other awards stay at their current dollar amount.
