## 1. **Editorial Report** by Alces Editor, Pete Pekins:

- progress on recent volumes:

  - Vol. 56 (2020) Sugarloaf, Maine need more manuscripts.
- announced that Michelle Carstensen has been invited to become an Associate Editor.

## 2. Alces Budget by Business Editor, Art Rodgers:

- digital formatting of the journal continues to be done by CSP Publishing Services @ charge of \$30 CDN/page which matches page charge to authors.
- The 1-yr annual contract with CSP expires 31 Dec. 2019 but will be renewed.
- Alces is listed in the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ). Many thanks to Jason Ferrante (USGS, FL) for beginning to upload metadata for Vols. 53 & 54. More documentation needs to be provided for all issues in order to get more complete coverage.
- Back issues available online in PDF format:
  - Vols. 14 (1978) to 46 (2010) accessed on the old website.
  - Vols. 44 (2008) to 55 (2019) accessed on the new website.
- Alces Account at Lakehead Univeristy: Art gave details of annual revenue and expenses for the past 4 yrs.
- Three years ago, the Executive was directed to maintain a minimum Account of about \$75,000. Our average annual growth since 2011 has been \$ 4,262. Future savings on mailing costs, auction and meeting residues should reduce over-expenditure and keep us closer to the target minimum balance. The Account is currently at \$72,685.
